**Propeller Suspends Parking Fees for Paine Field Travelers**

*Airport Continues to Focus on Providing a Safe Environment and Best in Class Service for Travelers*

SEATTLE (March 19, 2020) — Propeller Airports announced today that parking fees will be suspended for all travelers flying out of the Paine Field Passenger Terminal in Everett. Amid increased travel concerns and restrictions due to the COVID-19 outbreak, the move makes it easier than ever for Puget Sound region travelers to take advantage of the terminal’s unique amenities, service and convenience. Today’s announcement follows recently enhanced cleaning protocols utilizing ultra-violet light technology to clean seating areas, security, restrooms and other high-touch areas in the terminal.

“We recognize that a lot of people will delay or cancel trips, but for those that are traveling during these uncertain times, we are committed to making it as easy, affordable and safe as possible for flyers coming in and out of Paine Field,” said Brett Smith, CEO of Propeller Airports. “Our airport is open for business and committed to maintaining a safe and healthy environment for our customers while continuing to provide a vital service to our community.”

Today through April 5, passengers flying out of Paine Field can park for free in any of the airport lots. Prior to departure passengers should take their parking ticket along with proof of travel to Propeller’s concierge desk located in ticketing to have their ticket validated.

Paine Field became the only airport in the country last week to implement patented UV technology to disinfect the terminal, including all kiosks, seating, tables and high-touch areas in the facility. The technology substantially reduces and, in some cases, eliminates the risk of infection from COVID-19 and other infectious diseases and bacteria, making Paine Field a safe choice for travelers.
